***VOCATIONAL FIELDS** eligible are the following or substantially similar skilled trades:

HVAC/R, welding, electrical, building construction, machining, automotive collision repair and refinishing, engine repair; or to teach in a vocational field.

Scholarship funds are paid directly to the training institution. Students enrolling or already enrolled in trade school classes which do not require tuition, such as BOCES programs, are not eligible for this award.
